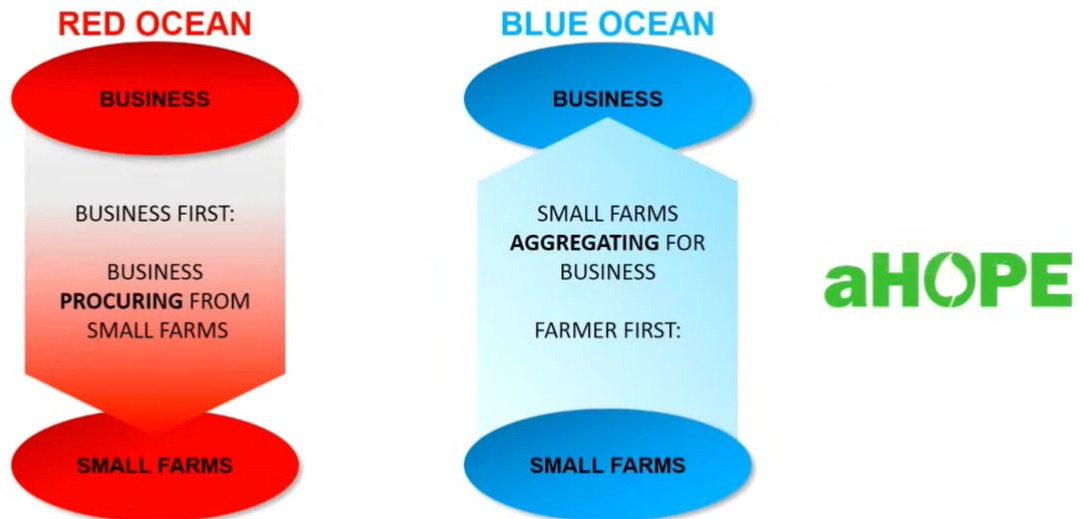
A promise of shared sustainable prosperity

Water from Air – Anytime, Anywhere

In the face of a global water scarcity crisis that affects billions and threatens 21 Indian cities to potentially run out of water by 2030, innovators Ramesh, Ankith, and their team have developed the VayuJal, an atmospheric water generator that produces clean drinking water by extracting humidity from the air.

This cutting-edge solution aims to reduce the environmental impact of traditional water sourcing and transportation, offering a sustainable alternative and a path towards preserving valuable groundwater resources.



Impact of Blue Ocean Awards

To date, over 90% of Blue Ocean Award winners were financed within 6 months of winning. Within 3 years after victory, the winner's valuations have increased on average tenfold and up to 40 times.

ECOSYSTEM BUILT SINCE 2014



Past winners include Compte-Nickel which was acquired by BNP Paribas for Euro 225 million, and Scalify, a world leader in cloud storage, in which Hewlett-Packard Enterprise invested \$10 million six months after it received its Blue Ocean Award.
